INTRODUCTION SO April O

Looking back, moving forward! Inner Insight is a Youth Exchange program that aims to build a bridge between the past and the future; focused on what is common for Europeans and how we can learn from history; foster reconciliation and constructive approaches to remembrance, and promote the European spirit of cooperation, understanding, and tolerance and active participation of young people. Different historical events had an impact on the social relationships of those involved and have created a context today in which an approach that promotes reconciliation and fosters remembrance is needed. This project is a continuation of the first edition Looking back, moving forward! in 2022, with special focus on media and its portrayal of war.

That is why 43 people, including coordinators, participants, and team leaders from all around Europe, got together to create a safe space to meet these objectives. They gathered information on the armed conflicts in their countries and on historical places, shared their views, and reflected on these topics. In the following e-booklet, they will summarise and share a bit about what they have been doing this week.





On the first day, all 43 participants arrived at the accommodation site until the late evening, they rested and introduced each other.

DAY THREE



DAY FOUR



In the morning they had an energizer to wake up the good spirits in people. Our awesome Serbian team prepared a workshop on the topic of personal and national identity. They prepared flowers in which everyone had to write down their 8 things that identify their identity. Like their religion, nationality, beliefs ..

Afterwards the workshop of our Italian group started. Workshop on the topic of prejudices and stereotypes. Participants had to compare facts about their countries and, through humor, tell some of the most popular stereotypes about the people from different countries. In the end we concluded that those are only stereotypes and that we can't judge people.

After that the Macedonian team had a workshop about critical thinking in which we had to write about past wartime events and discuss how they were perceived at the time. In this workshop they saw how the media can sometimes distort the way we view events because of their own biases and agendas.

DAY FOUR



The workshops were followed by showing media clippings about past wars related events, collected by each national team as an assignment before the youth exchange. The clippings were discussed and they all saw how historical events were perceived at the time of their happening and the biased way the media portrayed them in that time. They all learned that every story has multiple sides and that we should not always believe the first or even official version of a story, especially if the story is related to something controversial like war or national rivalries where powerful interests are involved.

At the end of the day the Turkish and Macedonian teams had their intercultural evening in which they presented their countries, food and culture through fun events.

DAY FIVE

On the 15th of April, the participants went on a field trip to the town Knin. Knin is a very old historical town in Croatia, close to the Bosnian border. It is also a place where the war in Croatia ended. It was the place where the final military operation on Croatian soil was played out.

The participants entered the bus in the morning and travelled for an hour and a half to Knin. Immediately they saw the historical richness of Knin, all the old buildings and an old fortress hovering above the entire town.

They all went to the fortress, which hosts a museum of the Croatian war for independence. In the museum they learned about the atrocities of the war and the way it was all portrayed in the media back then. It was an important thing to learn as they never media back then. 

Although my flat was fully furnished, it was dangerous to stay there. One day I got a VCR tape with an interesting recently released American film. My brother (who was an active soldier) had a free evening and we decided to watch the film in my flat. We couldn't turn the lights on so we sneaked into my flat and covered the skylight windows. "Definitely, songs. There were a lot of songs called budnice which were written to embolden the people and promote the morale of the troops. I have to point out the song Moja Domovina. The song showed unity and the lyrics were about the beautiful countryside of Croatia."

Have you experienced or been told of any case in which someone from one of the sides in the conflict helped someone from the opposite side who was in danger, in trouble?

"I remember a story of a local doctor in 110k. This area was one of the firstly conquered areas by the JNA (Yugoslav People's Army). Every conquered area was almost immediately divided by nationalities that lived in harmony before the war. This doctor, although he was of Serb nationality, protected the local Croatian people from Serbian troops, not only as their doctor, but as their neighbour and fellow human being."

"Till now if you visit Kosovo at first you can not visit Serbia because the Serbian Government is forbidden. If you want to visit Serbia you have to pass through another country."


Is there an object or habit that you cling to keep you positive during the most difficult times? "I still have a picture with Kosovo's flag and color that sings our National anthem."

"I remember we pissed off the soldiers and then quickly fled to our homes,". He said that because of the blockage of going out, they were very bored and they could not leave their homes for a while.

"I didn't have such an object or material that made me stay positive, but as a habit I was often praying. -My belief in Allah and goodness has kept me alive."

Have you experienced or been told of any case in which someone from one of the sides in the conflict helped someone from the opposite side who was in danger, in trouble?

"If someone's acquaintance was imprisoned, both moral and material support was provided by their neighbors."


What do you know about the war?

Can you remember the last conflict that you witnessed in Serbia?


"The last conflict that I can remember is the NATO Bombarding of Serbia in 1999."

SPAIN

This is a story about a child called Carmen Fernandez who was born in Jerez de la Frontera (a city in Andalucía, Spain) in 1929 and, unfortunately, died in 2020. Carmen was an only child (she had a stepsister, with whom she didn't have any contact, that was born from a relationship between Carmen's father and another woman) and she was living in a street in the city centre of Jerez.

The anecdote that her son told us takes place during the years of the Spanish Civil War (1936-1939), probably in 1936-1937, as Carmen was 7 years old. SPAIN

Carmen was playing in the streets. Suddenly, various Italian fascist soldiers ("Black Shirts", who received an emergency call, came running and one of them stepped on Carmen's leg and he broke it. After this happened, Carmen's family took her to the hospital to cure her. While she was at the hospital, she received the visit of said soldier who broke her leg that brought her a doll. This same doll turned into an important object for his mother, because dolls were really expensive back then and this doll had a lot of details and was really beautiful. For all these aesthetic reasons and also for the meaning behind how she got this doll, Carmen tried to store it properly but, in the end, she had to throw it away.

Her son considers this as a "positive anecdote" in a war because even if people were in a conflictual situation, a soldier remembered her and looked for her to give her a present, because he knew that he had hurt an innocent child.




